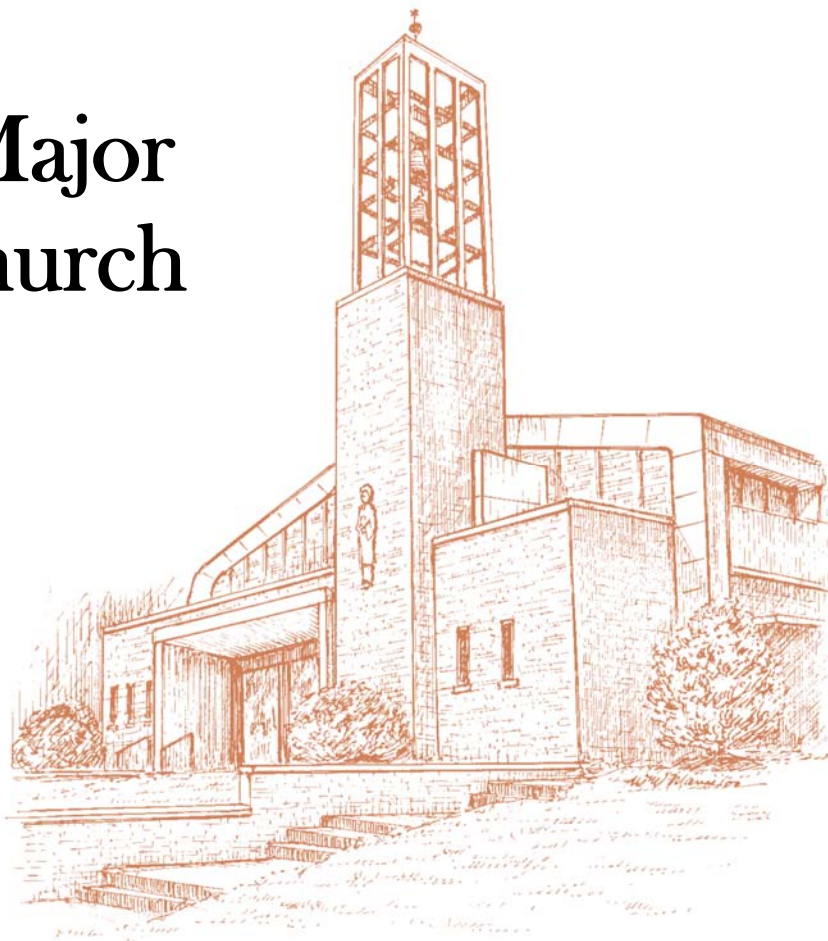

This weekend we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.



The purpose of the rosary is to help us meditate on the great mysteries of our salvation. Pius XII called it a compendium of the Gospel. The main focus is on Jesus—His Birth, Life, Death, and Resurrection. The Our Fathers remind us that Jesus' Father is the initiator of salvation. The Hail Marys remind us to join with Mary in contemplating these mysteries. They also make us aware that Mary was and is intimately joined with her Son in all the mysteries of His earthly and heavenly existence. The Glory Be to the Father prayer reminds us that the Trinity is the fundamental Christian Mystery.
