

Pentecost

Fifty days after the Resurrection of Christ (Easter), the Apostles and their followers were gathered in a room. Jews from all over the world were gathered with Peter, the leader of the Apostles and the Eleven. At this time, a great wind blew and a flame appeared as a tongue of fire, which split itself into many individual flames above the heads of all those present. The Holy Spirit came upon these people and each began to speak in his own language. Despite the fact many had no common language, they were perfectly able to understand one another. This was the feast of Pentecost, called the birthday of the Church. Those who received the Spirit at this time began their earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations. The symbols of Pentecost are the flame, wind and the dove which represent the Holy Spirit. The color of Pentecost is red.


