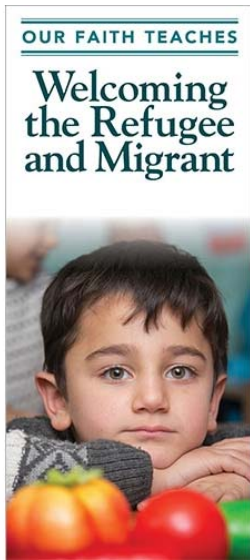

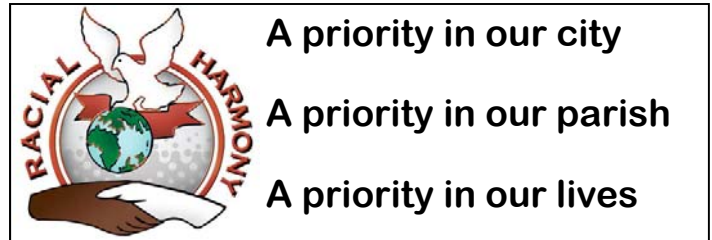
Welcoming the Refugee and Migrant
